The outside fabric is a cotton from Kokka. The inside fabric is a solid from [Purl](#) but I can't remember which line. I didn't have any heavy weight interfacing so there is a layer of heavy canvas in the middle. I also used the canvas for the handles with some fancy ribbon I found at a shop in town.
