



Dog Bone for Indoor Fetch

cut 2
seam allowance is 1/2"

Tools & Materials Instructions

scraps of heavy weight cotton
thread
stuffing
scissors
sewing machine
pins
pencil

1. Cut out your pattern piece.
2. Pin the pattern to your fabric and cut around it. Repeat for a second piece of fabric.
3. Pin fabric pieces together, right sides in, and sew around leaving an opening as shown by the dotted line.
4. Trim seam allowance to about 1/4", clip curves and turn your toy right side out.
5. Stuff your toy with small pieces of stuffing material until it is firm. The eraser end of a pencil is really handy for this.
6. Fold in the seam allowance on the open end of your toy and machine sew closed.
7. Toss your toy and hope someone brings it back to you.
